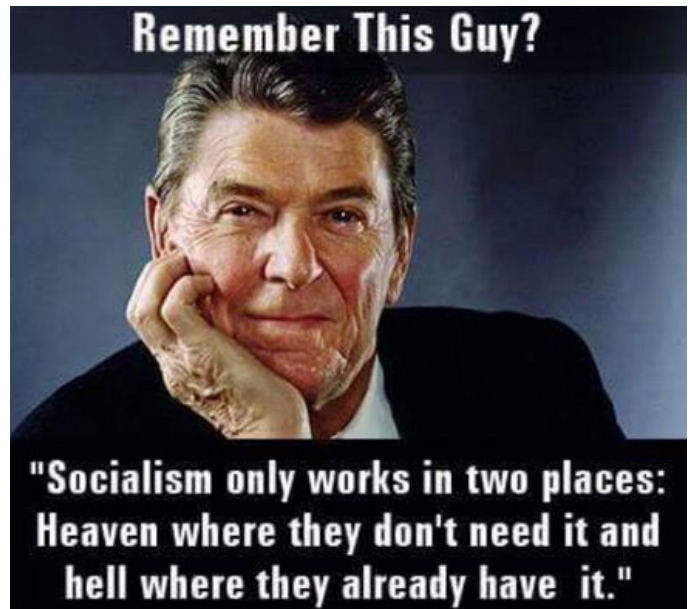

HANDGUN 101 & SELECTION

We understand that shooting can be intimidating, so we take all the time needed to make sure you feel comfortable with a handgun. The course covers gun safety, parts of the handguns, ammunition and ammunition selection, loading/unloading, grip, stance, and more. Students then get one on one instruction on the range while shooting a variety of handguns to see which gun fits them the best.

EXPERIENCE LEVEL: Beginner

DURATION: ≈ 4.5 hours

COURSE FEE: \$120, includes handguns, ammunition, eye & ear protection

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENT: None but students may bring a personal firearm to shoot in place of one of ours.

NOTES:

- Firearm "selection" will be based on ammunition availability
- Valid ID required for range access
