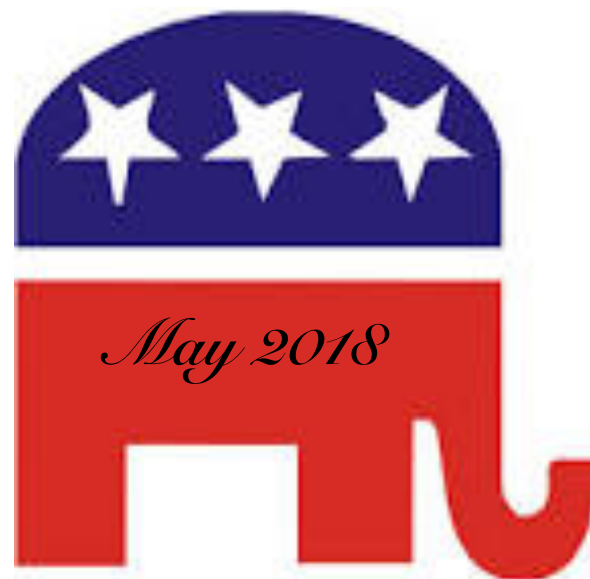

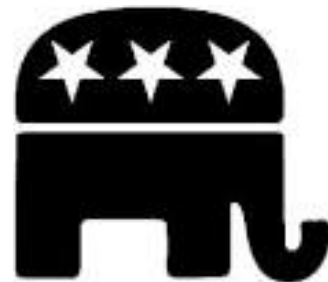
Don't forget we will not be meeting on June 5th because it's Election Day. We will be meeting on June 12th and will get a legislative update from several of our local legislators.

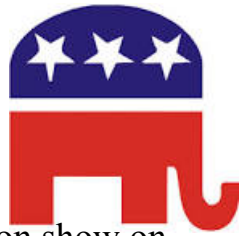

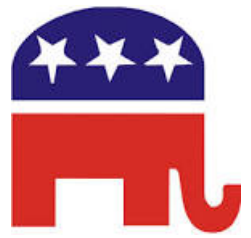
2018 Fashion Show

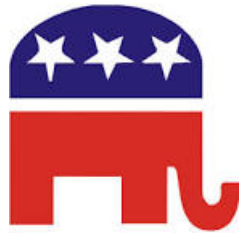

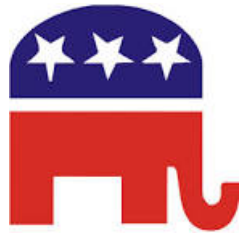
