## U.S. Senate Candidate BBQ & Forum



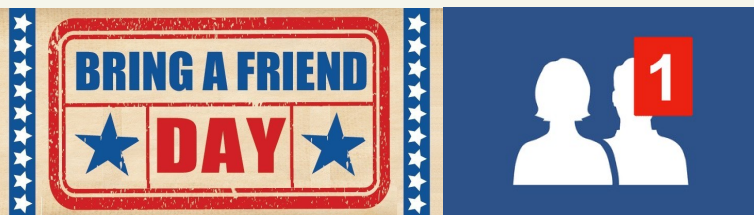

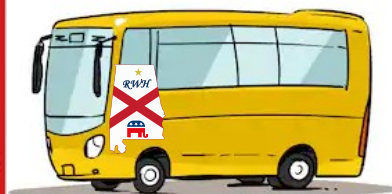
